FEES AND COSTS FROM FEBRUARY 1, 2019 THROUGH MAY 31, 2019

The Motion for Order Approving and Authorizing Payment of Temporary Receiver's and Professional's Fees and Costs From February 1, 2019 Through May 31, 2019 ("Motion") filed by the temporary receiver, Rohb Evans & Associates LLC ("Receiver") came before this Court for determination pursuant to regularly noticed motion. The Court, having read and considered the Motion and all pleadings and evidence filed in support thereof, and opposition to the Motion, if any, and good cause appearing therefore, it is

ORDERED that:

1. The Motion and all relief sought therein is granted in its entirety;
2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the following fees and costs incurred from February 1, 2019 through May 31, 2019 ("Second Expense Period") are hereby approved and authorized to be paid from the assets of the receivership estate:

A. The fees of the Receiver, including the Receiver's members and staff, of \$399,820.20 and Receiver's costs of \$12,981.60, for a total of \$412,801.80; and

B. The fees of the Receiver's counsel, Barnes & Thornburg LLP ("Barnes & Thornburg") of \$298,683.70 and costs of \$7,001.58, for a total of \$305,685.28.
