[PROPOSED] ORDER CONFIRMING RECEIVER'S POSSESSION OF AND CONTROL OVER ASSETS PREVIOUSLY ORDERED TO BE TURNED OVER

The Federal Trade Commission ("FTC") has moved the Court to enter an order confirming the Receiver's possession of and control over assets previously ordered to be turned over or relinquished to the Receiver. Having considered the FTC's motion, **IT IS HEREBY**ORDERED:

- A. Absent further order of the Court, no Receivership Asset, as that term is defined in DE 1194 and DE 1112, shall be returned to any of the Defendants.
- B. The Receiver shall retain exclusive control, custody, and possession of all Receivership Assets, as that term is defined in DE 1194 and DE 1112, pursuant to the provisions governing the appointment of the Receiver and the Receiver's duties and authorities, DE 1194, Sections VI-VII, and DE 1112, Sections VI-VII.
- C. Because the Receiver shall maintain its control, custody, and possession of all Receivership Assets, the Stay of Actions provisions in DE 1194, Section VIII, and DE 1112, Section VIII, shall also remain in effect.
