

The Court has before it the FTC's Motion to Reform and Reaffirm Final Orders (ECF No. 1404), the Represented Defendants' Opposition to the same (ECF No. 1405), and the FTC's Reply (ECF No. 1408).

The Court only has a proposed order from the FTC. Although the Court understands that the Represented Defendants oppose most, if not all, of what the FTC's proposed order sets forth, the Represented Defendants, in their Opposition, appear to be asking for certain independent relief that is not covered by the FTC's proposed order.

Accordingly, the Court directs the Represented Defendants, within twenty (20) days, to submit a proposed order or orders setting forth the relief that they propose. The FTC shall have twenty (20) days thereafter to oppose any order that may be proposed by Represented Defendants, and the Represented Defendants shall have ten (10) days thereafter to reply to said proposed order or orders.

Despite the informal nature of this ruling, it shall constitute an Order of the Court and the Clerk is directed to docket it accordingly.
