**[AMENDED PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ORDER APPROVING
AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF RECEIVER'S AND PROFESSIONALS' FEES
FROM OCTOBER 1, 2023 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023**

The Motion for Order Approving and Authorizing Payment of Receiver's and Professionals' Fees and Costs From October 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 (together with the Receiver's July 2, 2024 Noticed of Amended Proposed Order, the "Motion") filed by the Receiver, Marc-Philip Ferzan of Ankura Consulting Group, LLC ("Receiver"), came before this Court for determination pursuant to regularly noticed motion. The Court, having read and considered the Motion and all pleadings and evidence filed in support thereof, and opposition to the Motion, if any, and good cause appearing therefore, it is

ORDERED that:

1. The Motion is granted as set forth herein;
2. The following fees and costs incurred from October 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 are hereby approved and authorized to be paid immediately from the assets of the receivership estate: (a) Receiver's fees, including the fees of the Receiver's team at Ankura Consulting Group, LLC, of \$110,090.34 and Receiver's costs of \$13,075.82, for a total of

\$123,166.16; and (b) Receiver's counsel Barnes & Thornburg LLP's fees of \$86,626.80 and costs of \$3,548.28, for a total of \$90,175.08.

3. In accordance with the Court's June 18, 2024 Order Regarding Billing Guidelines for the Receiver and its Counsel, the following additional fee amounts incurred from October 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 are hereby held back and will be paid at the Court's discretion as part of the final fee request submitted at the close of the receivership: (a) Receiver's fees, including the fees of the Receiver's team at Ankura Consulting Group, LLC, of \$12,232.26; and (b) Receiver's counsel Barnes & Thornburg LLP's fees of \$9,625.20.
